Stop the Bleed Training and Kits


Heatstroke Prevention

Child heatstroke fatalities in 2017 were 43 fatalities with 791 fatalities since 1998. A child can die from heatstroke in 10 minutes! *Look before you lock!*

Lightning Strike Education

Based on data since 1980, lightning causes 3 fatalities and 12 injuries per year in Colorado which ranks among the top five states for fatalities and injuries. In an average year, about 500,000 lightning flashes hit the ground in Colorado.

With that in mind, golfers, swimmers, hikers and hunters need to know how to stay safe when the skies turn angry.
