The poster should include your project title, project background information, materials and methods, literature cited, acknowledgments, results, conclusions and contact information for further information if requested.

Posters are due July 1, 2018 in .pdf format to Shirley Terry at shirleyterry@comcast.net. All poster submissions will be reviewed and accepted by the National EMS Safety Summit Leadership Planning Committee. Approvals will be determined and communicated to poster submitters by July 15, 2018.
